
## Iraq as a tourist destination

potential through its historical landmarks. Apart from that, it many different types tourist destination, as Babylon is attractions and tourists continue to visit the country despite the security situation problems.




Lakes, waterfalls, rivers, plains, and valleys: There are many lakes, waterways and waterfalls in Iraq. In the middle and south


