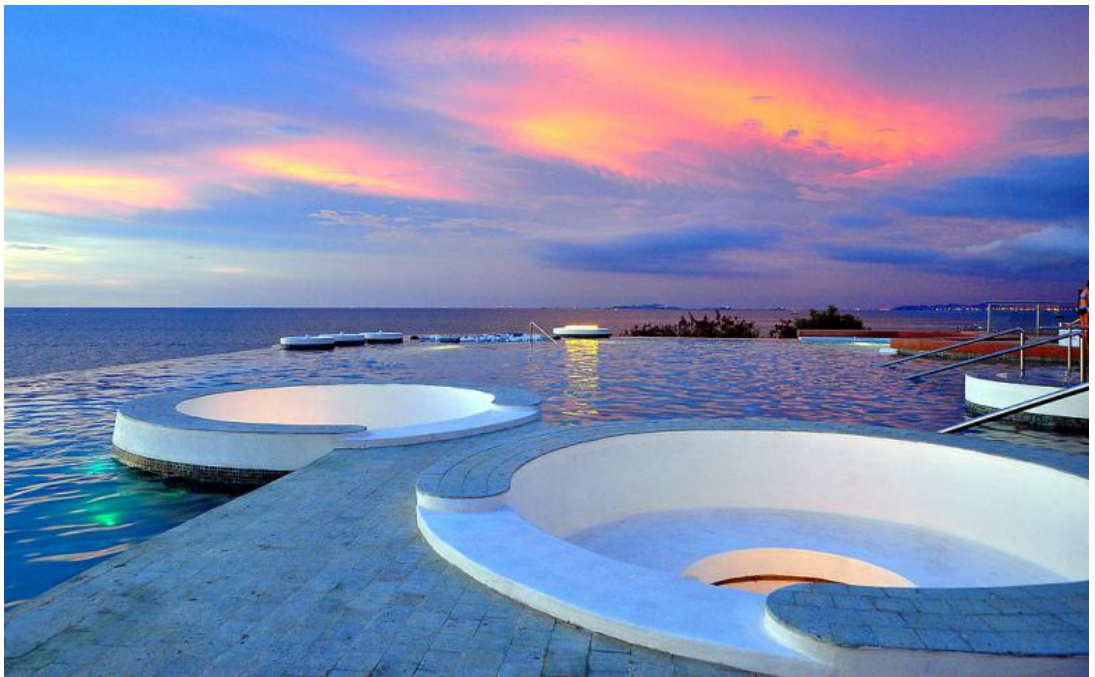
Q: I saw a certificate that you have the Halal Food here in The Royal Cliff, can you tell me about it and other facilities for Middle East Visitors?
